
GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS & COURSES

Requirements differ by student status. There are three sets of general education requirements

- 1) [UB/SUNY General Education](#) (for all students entering Fall '02 and later)
- 2) [University General Education](#) (for some students entering prior to Fall '02)
- 3) [Knowledge Area](#) (for some continuing students who first enrolled prior to Fall'02 and entered with 24 or more transferable semester credit hours from an institution of higher education other than UB)

Please note that there are different requirements for: (1) students who entered as freshmen; (2) students who entered with 24 or more transferable semester credit hours from an institution of higher education other than UB; (3) re-entering students who were recently enrolled at UB; (4) re-entering students last enrolled more than five years ago; (5) students enrolled for a second bachelor's degree; (6) students enrolled who have a completed bachelor's degree from a foreign institution; and (7) students with a registered learning disability.

Advising Notes:

S/U grading is not an option in any course used to satisfy general education requirements.

Internship, Independent Study, Undergraduate Teaching, Experiential Learning, and other courses not based on classroom experiences may not be used to meet general education requirements.

Any course may be applied toward only one general education requirement.

The UB/SUNY general education courses must meet the minimum guidelines listed in the chart below for the assigned course category, which were established by the Office of the Provost of the State University of New York in 2000. Student performance in courses is periodically reviewed to insure that the goals of the General Education Program are achieved.
